

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6 P.M., WEDNESDAY, May 14, 2021 CDT after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. Changes, additions or corrections must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those entries received by telephone are not acceptable.

MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE to North Arkansas Kennel Club (NAKC) ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MAILED WITH FEES to Sherry Gibbany, 1483 Harding Blvd, Cotter, AR 72626.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add \$25.00 fee to the amount of each returned check

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED without fees or signature. Entries not on Official AKC forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED for errors on entry blanks or for cancellation of entries after published closing date. There will be no refund in the event that a dog is absent, disgualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Event Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, or act of God, public emergency, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the North Arkansas Kennel Club.

THE NORTH ARKANSAS KENNEL CLUB, the Trial Secretary, Trial Chairperson, Event Committee, etc. assume no responsibility for the loss, damage, or injuries sustained by spectators, exhibitors, exhibitors' property and their dogs, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

DOGS NEED TO BE PRESENT for scheduled judging. Consult judging program for time of judging. JUDGES NEED NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog in the ring.

MOVE-UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED PER AKC Regulations. Obedience and Rally Move-ups must be given to the Trial Secretary by 30 minutes before trial start time.

JUMPS: Please put the jump height on the obedience and/or rally entry (if your dog is entered in a class with jumps). On Saturday and Sunday rally jump heights will be set lowest to highest.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH OR CRATED except when being judged.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted in the trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season after closing date will be refunded minus \$5.00 each trial entered. A written statement from a veterinarian must be provided on or before the day of the trial.

THIS IS A NON-SMOKING FACILITY.

CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED by an adult at all times. NO STROLLERS ALLOWED.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

There will be no concessions but snack type foods will be provided and lunch will be provided.

#### Move-Ups

Move-ups will be allowed at this trial per AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. Move-ups close one half hour prior to judging each day. Request must be in writing prior to the event. It is recommended that move-up requests be sent by email to the Trial Secretary prior to day of show. If an email address is provided with your request, an email confirmation will be sent.

COVID-19 AKC Guidelines will 6be conducted to the best of our ability. Please abide by state mandates about mask wearing, sanitizing and 6 ft distancing. Be mindful of your crating, if you are in a group together can crate together but try to maintain distancing when possible.

Once a judge reaches his 8 hr limit (# of dogs based on COVID 19 AKC) then no more entries will be accepted.



**From the East:** Hwy 62/412 W to Mountain Home. Turn left onto Sheid Hopper Bypass/US62 HWY 412 W for 5.5 miles. Turn right onto Hwy 62. Turn right onto W. Wade for 0.3 miles. Turn right onto Fairgrounds Drive.

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety your are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 inches, over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired); Collies (rough, smooth); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
