Transfers will be allowed at this trial per AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16a. Transfers close one half hour prior to judging each day. Request must be in writing prior to the event. It is recommended that move-up requests be sent by email to the Trial Secretary prior to day of show. If an email address is provided with your request, an email confirmation will be sent.

AKC Event & Recording Fees

Each entry includes an AKC Recording Fee of \$4.50 for the first entry of each dog and AKC Event Service Fee of \$4.50 shall be required for each additional entry of the same dog in both Obedience and Rally. (Chapter 11, Section 2 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Recording Fees and Event Service Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. Entry Fees Includes the AKC recording and service fee.

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club. Including ILP/PAL registration, AKC Canine Partners listing number, and Approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness, which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 14 of the Obedience Regulations for further restrictions. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.

ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6 P.M., FRIDAY, July 10, 2026 CDT after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. Changes, additions or corrections must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those entries received by telephone are not acceptable.

MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE to North Arkansas Kennel Club (NAKC) ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MAILED WITH FEES to Sherry Gibbany, 158 Bland St, Cotter, AR 72626.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 fee to the amount of each returned check.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED without fees or signature. Entries not on Official AKC forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made, and no entry accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at secretary's address. Entries will NOT be accepted without signature, fees and back of entry form, with agreement signed nor will credit card or faxed entries be accepted with paper entries. All entries, including overnight and express mail are to be mailed with fees payable to "NSGRC" to secretary's address. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WHICH REQUIRE A SIGNATURE FOR DELIVERY.**

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED for errors on entry blanks or for cancellation of entries after published closing date. **There will be no refund** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Event Committee. **Entry fees will not be refunded** if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, or act of God, public emergency, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the North Arkansas Kennel Club.

THE NORTH ARKANSAS KENNEL CLUB, the Trial Secretary, Trial Chairperson, Event Committee, etc. assume no responsibility for the loss, damage, or injuries sustained by spectators, exhibitors, exhibitors' property and their dogs, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

DOGS NEED TO BE PRESENT for scheduled judging. Consult judging program for time of judging. **JUDGES NEED NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG** holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog in the ring.

TRANSFERS WILL BE ACCEPTED PER AKC Regulations. Obedience and Rally Transferst must be given to the Trial Secretary by 30 minutes before trial start time.

JUMPS: Please put the jump height on the obedience and/or rally entry (if your dog is entered in a class with jumps). All days of trial rally and obedience jump heights will be set highest to lowest.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH OR CRATED except when being judged.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted in the trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season after closing date will be refunded the full entry fee. A written statement from a veterinarian must be provided on or before the day of the trial.

THIS IS A NON-SMOKING FACILITY INCLUDES NO VAPING.

CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED by an adult at all times. **NO STROLLERS ALLOWED.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Consult the AKC Regulations for Obedience and Rally Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry to these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es) and height divisions.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to exhibitor.

Change of Entry: Entry changes emailed to the Trial Secretary are not official until the exhibitor has received a return email confirmation from the Trial Secretary.

OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING ALL INFORMATION IN THE CONFIRMATION LETTER EACH TIME IT IS SENT AND CONTACTING TRIAL SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING/EMAIL IF A CORRECTION OR CHANGE NEEDS TO BE MADE. Correct AKC Registration #, PAL # or ILP # is crucial.

Any exhibitor who has not received a preliminary confirmation within 10 days of mailing a paper entry, please contact Trial Secretary to confirm receipt of paper entry.

Any exhibitor who does not receive the Judging Program within five (5) days prior to the trial, should contact the Trial Secretary.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning after their own dogs, including the motels and campgrounds, which are considered part of the trial site.

No dogs are allowed to left overnight.

No unentered dogs are allowed.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

ENTRY INFORMATION CONTINUED

The Trial Committee may require that the crate of any dog creating a disturbance in the crating area, through lunging, barking, growling, or other actions, be covered with opaque material.

Trial Committee members may rearrange crates to maximize space if needed, including restricting placement of chairs in the crating area. Please crate in the specified areas. Your co-operation is appreciated.

Please abide by the AKC Code of Sportsmanship and Civility flyer emphasizing positive exhibitor conduct and adhere to the following principles:

Treat all participants, including competitors and officials, with respect and courtesy.

Exhibit good sportsmanship by accepting wins and losses graciously.

Support fellow competitors and celebrate their achievements.

Follow the rules and regulations of the sport without exception.

Maintain a positive attitude and encourage a friendly atmosphere.

Report any misconduct or unsportsmanlike behavior to the appropriate individuals, Trial Chair or anyone on event committee.

Any misconduct or unsportsmanlike behavior may result in event committee meeting.

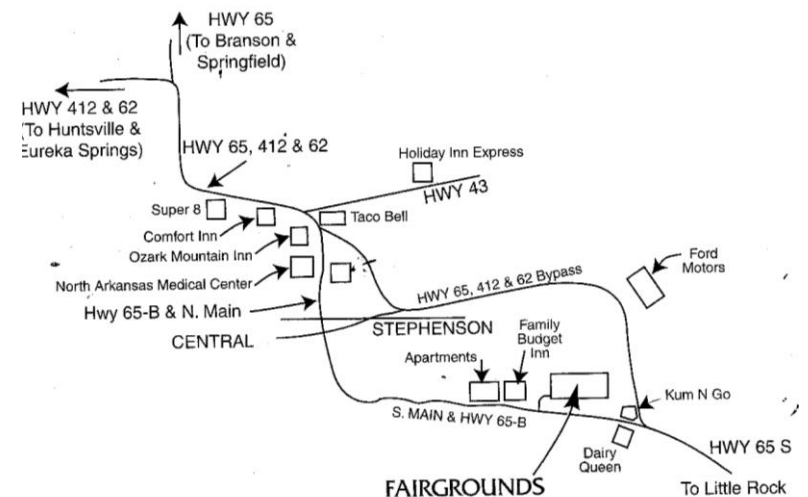
DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From the North:

Off of Highway 65 S turn left onto Highway 65 S, 62/412 E at the light (Taco Bell on corner) Go 3.5 miles to Highway 65B (this is also South Main) turn right (Kum N Go on corner). Go 4/10 of a mile to entrance of Fairgrounds, turn right at entrance, go up the hill and turn right.

From the South:

Turn left off of Highway 65 N onto Highway 65 B (this is also South Main). Go 4/10 of a mile to entrance of Fairgrounds, turn right at entrance, go up the hill and turn right through the gates into the Fairgrounds.
